**Subject: Availability of the Livermore Municipal Airport's
FINAL Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) and Commencement of the
Required 180-day Local Agency Review**

Dear Colleague,

As you know, the Alameda County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) recently completed a multi-year process to update the 1986 *Airport Land Use Policy Plan*. This Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) Update has been guided by the Caltrans Division of Aeronautics *California Airport Land Use Planning Handbook*, the ALUC Commissioners, consultation with jurisdictions involved, and members of the public. The ALUCPs for the county's three public-use airports were adopted and became effective on these dates:

- Oakland International Airport - December 15, 2010
- Hayward Executive Airport - July 18, 2012
- Livermore Municipal Airport - July 18, 2012

Once an Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan has been amended and adopted by the ALUC, state law provides that a local agency must either modify its local plan(s) (Gov. Code §65302.3(b)-(c)) or alternatively, adopt specific findings and overrule the ALUC within 180 days of when an ALUC adopts or amends its ALUCP (PUC §21676(b)). Specific information regarding these requirements can be found in Appendix A – State Law Related to Airport Land Use Planning—in the ALUCP for the Livermore Municipal Airport. A CD containing the FINAL adopted ALUCP for the Livermore Municipal Airport is included with this letter.

Please note that the required 180-day review period will commence on Monday October 1, 2012, and conclude Friday March 29, 2013. Should your staff require more information or have questions during this time, do not hesitate to contact ALUC staff at 510-670-5400.
