Your Comments: Downtown congestion makes life difficult. I have to pass through downtown often on my way to Ken Mercer Sports park. It is impossible to make a left turn on Main Street from St. Mary's after school is out until 7 pm daily. (I don't even try to turn left onto Main Street from St. Marys at this time anymore.)
