SUBJECT: REVIEW THE DRAFT CONCEPTUAL ALTERNATIVES FOR THE WEST LAS POSITAS BOULEVARD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN CORRIDOR

The City and Toole Design Group have been working on the West Las Positas Boulevard (WLP) bicycle and pedestrian corridor improvement plan, which focuses on completing the top ranked corridor from the master plan and creating a continuous, east-west bikeway in north Pleasanton providing access to neighborhoods, employment centers and schools. The Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee serves as the Advisory Committee for the process.

Staff has now received the draft concept design plans for the various alternatives along the West Las Positas corridor and provided it to the BPTC for review and comment.

Toole Design will present an overview of the draft concept alternatives, including an oral summary on the information that was obtained from the September 19, 2019 community workshop and the September 21, 2019 Farmer's Market and Iron Horse Trail pop-up events. The draft concept plans can be viewed on the project's website (www.WLPbike.com).

It is recommended that the Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee review the draft concept plans for the West Las Positas corridor and provide feedback.
