

BUSINESS DESCRIPTION

Education Enrichment Center (EEC)

The Education Enrichment Center (EEC) has been in existence at 1204 Serpentine Lane, Suite 112, Pleasanton for six plus years, operating under the current PCUP-186 and Business License number 104269. We, Yeon Hee Han and Moon Hee Park, purchased the business three years ago.

We offer various supplemental education enrichment programs for young students 5-18 years old. The classes are held from 3:30-7:30 pm Tuesday through Friday and Saturday 9:00 am -6:00 pm. Maximum number of students in the building at one time will be 12-16. Parking is really only needed for staff members as parents mainly drop off and pick up students.

Parking

The Quarry Business Center consists of four (4) individual buildings totaling 77,200±SF. There are 258 parking stalls including eight (8) handicap stalls. Each tenant is allocated one parking space for each 300±SF of office space they lease. In our case, EEC will be leasing 2,491±SF so we will have eight (8) parking spaces to use. This project currently has a 33% vacancy rate but historically even at full occupancy there is still more parking available than allocated.

At the Education Enrichment Center, with only 3-4 staff members on site at one time and with most parents dropping off students, the parking should be more than adequate to cover our needs.

Education Enrichment Center (EEC)

Description of Curriculum

The Education Enrichment Center offers tutoring in Language Arts and Math for grades Kindergarten through 12th. Language Arts tutoring encompasses Reading, Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary. We also offer AR (Accelerated Reading). Our Math tutoring covers grades 1st to 5th as well as Pre-Algebra, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Pre-Calculus and Calculus. Our maximum class size is 5 students.

We also offer tutoring for SAT Prep and AP (Advanced Placement) in Biology, Chemistry, Calculus, History and English. Maximum class size is 1 student.

All of our tutors are credentialed teachers. We follow the California Standards and use the same text books utilized by the public schools.

We also offer an Abacus class for K-3rd graders. Additionally, we have a Debate group for the middle school students.

With the exception Debate, the classes run either 1½ or 2 hours in length. For the 1½ hour long classes there is one 5 minute break at the 45 minute mark (approximately). The 2 hour long classes have 1 break at the 55 minute mark (approximately). The Debate class can run as long as 3 hours, but is usually shorter. Breaks are taken as needed.





Hi Jenny,

I am writing to express some concerns I have with the application for a conditional use permit to operate a tutorial facility for students in grades K-12. Unfortunately I am going to be out of town on June 26, 2013 and will be unable to attend the hearing and express my concerns there, so I am addressing them to you now, if you could please include them in your report, it would be greatly appreciated.

My biggest concern lies with the actual safety of students, given the industrial nature of the area and the accompanying truck traffic associated with the neighborhood I don't feel that any facility catering to children is a good fir for the area. I personally I would never enroll my children in any program in this type of area given safety concerns, I have 3 children one who is 18 months old a 5 year old going to kindergarten and an 8 year old going into 3rd grade, so my concern comes from personal experience.

Additionally, I have concerns about the impact that the traffic will create, a school like facility especially catering primarily to students too young too drive creates double the traffic with drop off and pick up. The Quarry Lane Preschool in the immediate area already creates a negative impact on the surrounding businesses as they do not have enough parking available both off and on the street to accommodate the traffic they create, and I feel the Quarry Lane Preschool is already a danger to the area, I can't count the number of near accidents that I have seen as a result of Quarry Lane Preschool.

If a conditional use permit is to be issued, I would like to see conditions attached to it that they must have sufficient off street parking to accommodate drop off and pick up of students without traffic overflowing onto the street and limit hours of operation so that student drop off and pick up will not occur at the same time as the Quarry Lane Preschool which could be an absolute nightmare to the surrounding businesses.
