The Studio will have 6 studios, 3 classrooms

What will be your hours of operations each day?

Front desk will be staffed 12-6 M-Th and 12-4 Fri (one person)

Lessons begin at 3:30 and finish by 8:30 Mon through Friday (all primarily after school). In addition, there will be some private piano instruction Tuesday 10am-11am, Wed 9am to 11am and Thursday 10am to Noon.

Lessons will also take place Saturday 9am to 1pm (private and small group).

How many instructions will take place at the same time?

I'm assuming you mean "instructors" - there are generally no more than 4 instructors at any one time currently. However, they could increase in the proposed location (one per room).

How many students at one time? a. individual lessons b. group lessons

a. 6 (one per small studio)

b. 9 (three per classroom)

The classrooms are capable of handling 4 students max in each, however full classes are rare and will most likely not coincide with other studios operating at full capacity.

What instruments taught? i.e. piano, keyboard, guitar

Piano, voice, guitar, brass, woodwinds and strings.

When doing keyboard, will it be done with earphones?

Sometimes, yes. Generally, piano groups play together but never louder than the instructor can speak.

Add anything else you think they will need.

The City is concerned with two things: noise and parking - everything else is essentially gravy. For the noise factor, we will point to the sound-proofing that is going in to the studio walls (perimeter between us and the surrounding businesses as well as between the studios themselves). As for parking, there is an abundance along the side of the building but, more importantly, a GREAT abundance along the west end of the property (along the creek) - that will come with the site plan I would think.
