**SUBJECT: DESIGNATE TWO MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING
COMMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HACIENDA PUD
MODIFICATION TASK FORCE**

BACKGROUND

The City of Pleasanton is starting to plan for a new mixed-use, transit-oriented development near the Pleasanton/Dublin BART station in Hacienda. At its November 3, 2009, meeting, the City Council approved the formation of a 19-member Task Force to guide this planning process, and the formation of an Advisory/Stakeholder Group that will provide public input from a wide range of interest groups and organizations, as well as technical assistance. A copy of the November 3, 2009, City Council agenda report describing the scope of work for the project and the public input process is attached.

The City Council has requested that the Planning Commission designate two members to serve on the Hacienda Planned Unit Development (PUD) Modification Task Force. The designees, together with other members of the Task Force will be confirmed at the City Council meeting of December 15, 2009. Staff anticipates that the Task Force will start work in January 2010, and will meet once or twice a month for one year or longer.

1. Designate two Planning Commissioners to serve on the Hacienda PUD Task Force

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
