MEETING SUMMARY

Below is a summary of the comments received from residents at the public outreach meeting for the proposed playground renovations at Orloff Park held on Saturday October 5, 2019 from 9:00-11:00 am. There were approximately 40 members of the public present at the event, with about 1/3 to 1/2 of the participants being children. Concept boards showing the playground options and components were presented during the event. Participants voted on their favorite playground components by placing stickers on the boards. Below is a summary of comments heard and favorite aspects of the playground concepts. The boards showing the voting results are also attached to the summary.

<u>Subject</u>

- 1. Remove the sandbox/litterbox from the play area for 5-12 year olds.
- 2. Keep the sandbox.
- 3. Provide speed limit signs and pathway lighting for the park.
- 4. Combine the elements into one playground for 2-12 year olds so all children can play together and so that it is easier to supervise children in the different age groups.
- 5. Add a shade tree on the south side of the play area for 2-5 year olds.
- 6. Add a xylophone or some other musical component to the play equipment.
- 7. Add adult exercise equipment to the, or next to, the play equipment for 2-5 year olds.
- 8. Add a regulatory sign that states that adult fitness classes cannot use the playgrounds. There are a number of CrossFit type classes that use the playgrounds currently.
- 9. Children in the neighborhood like that the play equipment for 2-5 year olds is a different color than the play equipment for 5-12 year olds. The playgrounds are known as the 'orange' and the 'blue' playground.
- 10. The more colors for the playground, the better.

- 11. The multi-generational swings are cool.
- 12. One resident would like to add a water feature that you can run through.
- 13. The children really like the monkey bars on the play equipment for 2-5 year olds.
- 14. Don't install a bumpy slide.
- 15. A resident liked the rock climbing wall on the play structure for 5-12 year olds.
- 16. A resident's granddaughter would love to see pink in the playground equipment.
- 17. A lot of the children like the existing dragon and tractor spring toys in the existing playground for 2-5 year olds.
- 18. A resident really liked the playground mound at the Magical Bridge playground in Palo Alto.
- 19. Signs should be posted near the playgrounds with the park rules, including that dogs should be on leashes.
- 20. The preferred color option was the red/green/blue color scheme by 20 to 4 votes.
- 21. The children would like to see the train incorporated into the design for the 2-5 year olds.
- 22. A couple kids really liked the teeter-totter.
- 23. The children really liked the spinner, the climber, and the tube in the playground for 5-12 year olds.
