SUBJECT: REVIEW THE HIGH AND LOW-COST PREFERRED DESIGN OPTIONS FOR THE WEST LAS POSITAS BOULEVARD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN CORRIDOR

SUMMARY

The City and Toole Design Group have been working on the West Las Positas Boulevard (WLP) bicycle and pedestrian corridor improvement plan, which focuses on completing the top ranked corridor from the master plan and creating a continuous, east-west bikeway in north Pleasanton providing access to neighborhoods, employment centers and schools. The Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee serves as the Advisory Committee for the process.

After reviewing the four design alternatives at the December 2019 Bicycle Pedestrian and Trails (BPTC) meeting, a preferred alternative was selected for greater refinement and cost estimate. Staff has attached the high and low-cost preferred design for the WLP corridor improvement plan. Staff is waiting on the cost estimate revisions at this time. Staff will present all this information at the January 27th BPTC meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee review the preferred high and low cost designs and provide feedback as necessary.

ACTION

Staff recommends the Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee forward the preferred high and low cost designs for the WLP corridor improvement plan to the City Council with a recommendation of approval.
