# SUBJECT: STATUS UPDATE ON THE WEST LAS POSITAS BOULEVARD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN CORRIDOR PLAN

#### SUMMARY

The City and Toole Design Group have been working on the West Las Positas Boulevard (WLP) bicycle and pedestrian corridor improvement plan, which focuses on completing the top ranked corridor from the master plan and creating a continuous, east-west bikeway in north Pleasanton providing access to neighborhoods, employment centers and schools. The Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trails Committee serves as the Advisory Committee for the process.

Due to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic and the Shelter-In-Place orders, the timeline for presenting the plan to City Council has been pushed back several months. At this time the WLP corridor plan is scheduled to be presented to City Council at the February 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. In addition, the WLP project website (<u>www.WLPbike.com</u>) has been updated to include the short and long-term preferred alternative and the draft feasibility report with cost estimates.

Staff encourages the BPTC members to attend the February 18<sup>th</sup> City Council to provide support/input for the WLP corridor project.

#### RECOMMENDATION
