

# CIVIC ARTS COMMISSION AGENDA REPORT

## SUBJECT: DISCUSS PUBLIC ART SELECTION SUBCOMMITTEE COMMISSION MEMBERS FOR 2024

### SUMMARY

Annually, the Civic Arts Commission discusses opportunities to participate on subcommittees. For 2024, subcommittee assignments will include the appointment of members for the Public Art Selection Subcommittee (PASS). The subcommittee includes Civic Arts commissioners, Parks and Recreation commissioners, community arts groups and City staff. PASS reviews, evaluates, and comments on proposed public art pieces for their location, artistic merit, installation, and long-term maintenance. The subcommittee meets monthly or as pieces are available for review.

Discuss Public Art Selection Subcommittee (PASS) commission members for 2024.

### BACKGROUND

In 2023, staff identified subcommittees for work that supported the Library and Recreation Strategic Plan goals (Attachment 1) and directly related to the duties of the Civic Arts Commission as outlined in the City of Pleasanton Municipal Code (Muni Code) Section 2.39.070 (Attachment 2). Once staff identified the need for a subcommittee, the Chairperson appointed commissioners as needed to serve on the subcommittees as outlined in the *City of Pleasanton Commissioner's Handbook* (Attachment 3).

### DISCUSSION

For 2024, subcommittee assignments will include the appointment of members for the Public Art Selection Subcommittee (PASS). PASS reviews, evaluates, and comments on proposed public art pieces for their location, artistic merit, installation, and long-term maintenance. The subcommittee meets monthly or as pieces are available for review. Prior to meeting, PASS members are emailed the proposed public art pieces and given time to review the piece and its proposed location. PASS has met in person and at the different proposed sites for public art. Subcommittee members include Civic Arts Commissioners, Parks and Recreation Commissioners, community arts groups and City staff. The subcommittee meets for one hour as needed, Fridays at noon.

One representative and one alternate commissioner is needed from both the Civic Arts and Parks and Recreation commissions.
